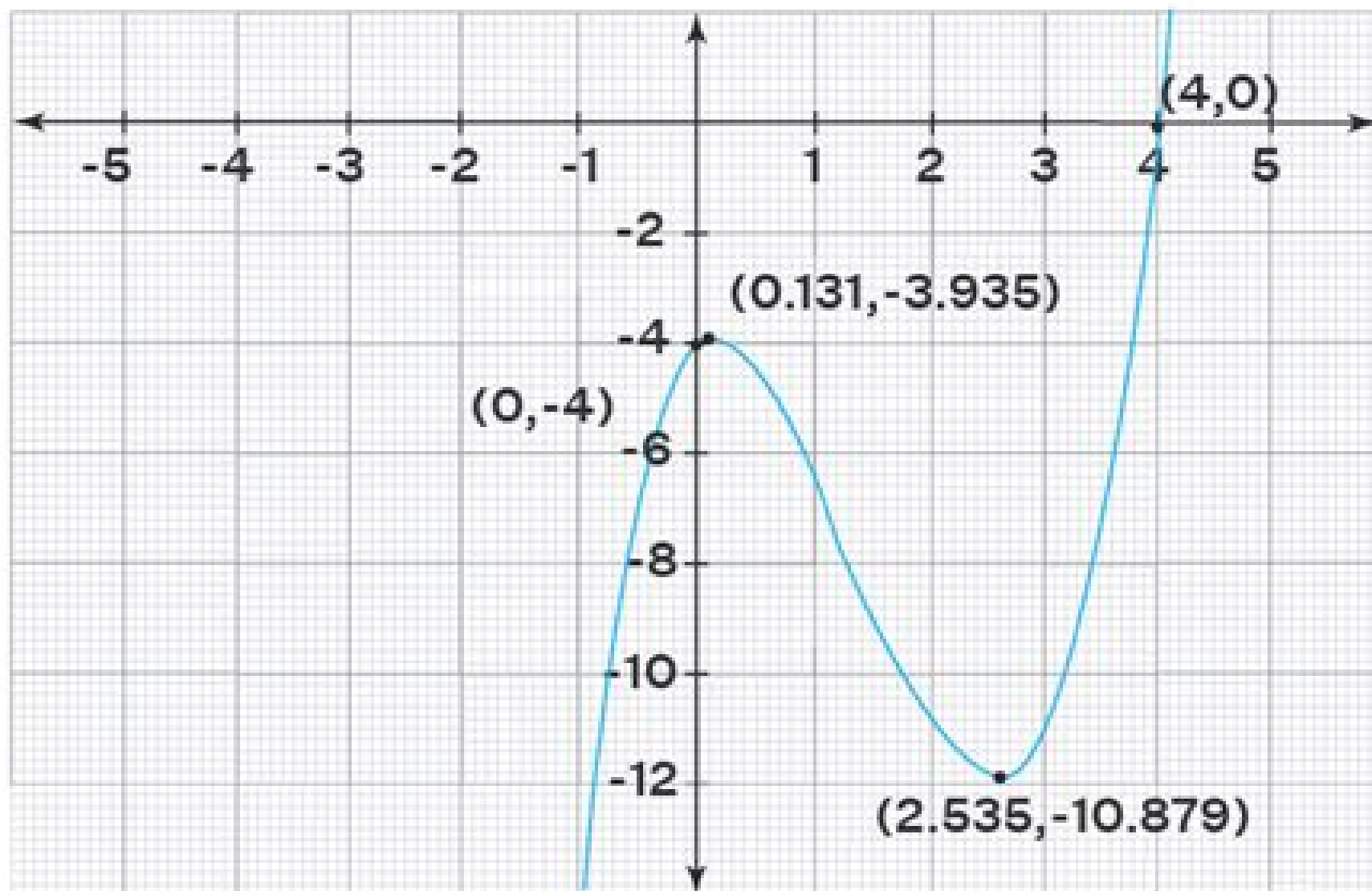


Graph of $f(x) = x^3 - 4x^2 + x - 4$
