Rationale for EBCC

- In a complex field and rapidly changing as oncology, clinical practice guidelines (CPG) are an important tool in patient care.
- Despite around millions of published papers from clinical trials; much of it presenting conflicting results, sometimes derived from poor-quality research methodology.



- Also, CPGs don't replace individual clinical expertise, and they can't be used in the absence of the patients' specific information. Factors such as comorbidities and individual preferences need to be considered.
- The ability to find and evaluate all the relevant studies, and draw robust conclusions from the totality of the evidence, takes skill and practice, and this is called
