1. On philosophy

From everything to almost nothing. It seems that philosophical schools have not even existed in the fullness of their activity in the West since ancient times. Perhaps because philosophy was stripped of ethics in the Middle Ages, which were determined by religious norms.

Medieval scholastic philosophy dealt with a fundamental reflection on the difference between the path of reason and faith and which of these two times is more valuable. This division separates philosophy from theology and ultimately results in the birth of materialism and modern science.

With this development and extremely brilliant philosophers in subsequent centuries, philosophy has challenged itself to become another positive science itself.

In addition, philosophy loses its connection with society and philosophical practice, and questions of ethical activity remain within the framework of religion. Philosophers continue to build ethical concepts, but their influence is reduced to the intellectual elite to which they belong.

Over time, the technological revolution and political, economic developments move society away from philosophical conceptions.

Where did the philosophical schools go? The problem of the world today is not only the absence of general philosophical conceptions but the vague images of the world as a whole. The overall cultural picture of the world is unclear. Historically, each culture has its image of the world, strongholds, the criteria on which the life of society as a whole is based. When cultural foundations are unclear, the future vision, the direction of action, and the effort's goal, today, each of these cultural aspects find no other goal beyond maintaining oneself, there is no connection or common determination, the goal of the activity is in itself. Politics serves politics, the art of art, the science of science, etc. [2] Somehow man and his betterment are excluded from all this, but this did not exclude the question of what are all cultural activities for if not the development and betterment of man? Man is alienated in the world of work. The humane content of human living is lacking. Unfortunately, modern philosophy, limited by its strongholds, did not answer how to overcome the existing problem. the two leading movements of the twentieth century, positives and anti-positives (philosophy of life, pragmatism, and philosophy of existence), uncompromisingly continue to follow their conceptions.

New winds. It is important to note that the focus of the last thirty years, from Foucalda, Derrida, Lacan, Žižek, Buttler, has shifted from philosophy as an independent discipline to an interdisciplinary theory that tries to devise the transfer of paradigmatic patterns from modernist to postmodern.
